Payment:

- Final payment is due no later than **August 19, 2013.**

TOUR PRICE

The tour price is based on:

- Round trip airfare on El Al Airline from Los Angeles International or JFK International Airport. In the unexpected event the airline adds unexpected fuel surcharges or fees, prices will increase.
- Two people sharing a room with private bath.
- Single rooms are subject to availability and higher room rate apply.
- Hotel and exchange rates in effect the date the tour was booked and on a specific number of tour members traveling together. In case of fewer participants, the price may increase.

TRIP PACKAGE

- **Included:** Round-trip airfare, buffet breakfast and dinner daily while in Israel, entrance fees, airport and departure taxes, portage, hotel tips and tips for drivers and guides.
- **Not Included:** Passports, individual visas, accident and cancellation insurance, portage at U.S. airports, any expense incurred resulting from injury or accident, loss of, damage to, or theft from luggage, and items of a personal nature such as laundry, phone calls, sodas, bottled water, and food or beverages not on the regular menu of the included meals. If in doubt whether a food or beverage is included, please ask the guide or the tour administrator.

REGISTRATION

Please make checks payable to Mission Valley Christian Fellowship. On the memo line write "2013 Israel Tour." A deposit is required to secure air and hotel reservations. Deposits received after the deposit deadline will be processed on a space available basis. **No registration will be processed without a deposit and a completed registration form.**

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

- \$500 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit is due no later than **June 10, 2013**.
- 50% of the remaining balance is due no later than **July 15, 2013**.
- Final payment is due no later than **August 19, 2013**.
- Failure to send in your payment at the proper time will result in forfeiture of your trip. You may at any time pay the full amount of your trip prior to scheduled dates.

ROOMMATES

The tour price is based on two persons in a twin-bed room. If you do not have a roommate, we will arrange one for you (unless you are among the last to register). If we are unable to arrange a roommate for you, you must pay the single occupancy charge (\$830.00, Israel), (\$1145.00, Israel/ Eilat). If this occurs, you will be informed within two weeks after your final payment deadline.

SIGHTSEEING

Itinerary is subject to change due to the local conditions in the country at the time of the tour. Adjustments in the program will be made if necessary.

MEMBERSHIP

In an honest endeavor to ensure congenial fellowship on the tour, the tour administrator reserves the right to refuse the application of anyone considered incompatible with the interests of the party as a whole. Applying for membership in this tour constitutes consent to abide by the discretion of the tour administrator and to defray any expenses resulting from dismissal from the tour.

PASSPORTS

- **U.S. Citizens:**
 - A copy of your passport is required no later than the date of the final payment. Your passport must **not** expire for at least six months after the date you will leave Israel.
 - In order to obtain a passport, go to your local main post office to pick up an application. **This should be done immediately.** An embossed birth certificate is required to obtain a passport. To obtain a birth certificate, contact the Hall of Records in the county in which you were born. U.S. citizens are not required to have a visa to enter Israel. No inoculations are currently required for Israel.
- **Non-U.S. Citizens:** You must inform the tour administrator of citizenship immediately and you must have a Resident Alien registration card (Green Card) in order to re-enter the U.S. Some foreign countries require a visa into Israel.

LUGGAGE

- Please bring one suitcase and one carry-on only. (This “one-suitcase” rule is due to limited storage space on the bus.)
- We will provide you with two luggage tags. One tag must be attached to the handles of your suitcase before you check it at the airport. This helps insure that your luggage will be handled with our group. The other tag is for your carry-on.
- Portage of one suitcase per person is included from your arrival until you check in for departure.
- You will be responsible at all times for your carry-on, so we suggest you keep it as lightweight as possible.
- To **avoid additional charges** and inconvenience, please **check with the airline for luggage rules and restrictions** regarding your check-in and your carry-on items.

CHANGES OR LATE BOOKINGS

If you want to depart before the group departs, return after the group returns, and/or visit countries not included in this tour, please inform the tour administrator in writing as soon as possible. Late bookings or changes made will be subject to a \$100 per change service fee plus airline charges.

CANCELLATION

- Cancellation of your trip is subject to any and all cancellation requirements of the airline and any costs paid by tour operators which cannot be recovered from hotels and foreign agencies.
- If you cancel after the final payment deadline, you will be liable for your roommate's single supplement cost.
- Total penalties may exceed 80% of the tour cost.
- All cancellations must be received by the tour administrator by fax or mail. **Cancellation may not be made by telephone.**
- Refunds are processed on a monthly basis.
- Cancellation after final payment deadline will require at least six to eight weeks processing time to recover funds paid.
- If the tour is cancelled through no fault of your own, you will be refunded in full less \$100.00 processing fee unless there are airline penalties involved.
